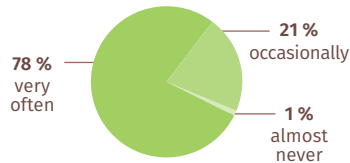

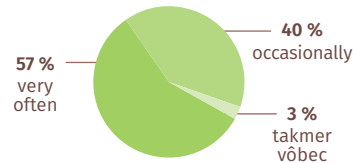

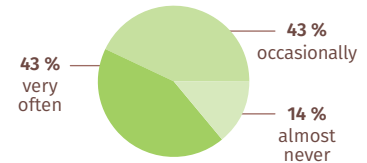

# Omamas career growth

## Promotion exams for junior positions

**In 2025, 12 Omamas were promoted to the junior position. To be promoted, they had to meet several criteria that verified their readiness.**

Each candidate had to have completed the beginner-level training, meaning they had to have been active in the OMAMA program for at least 6 months. Additionally, they were required to have led at least 5 parent clubs and conducted a minimum of 300 lessons in families. The selection process also included an online test based on the Omama Handbook, which assessed their professional knowledge through multiple-choice questions. Another important component was an evaluation visit by a supervisor from another region, who provided an independent perspective on the quality of fieldwork.

## Promotion exams for seniors

**In 2025, 11 Omamas were promoted to senior status. To qualify, they had to have been active in Cesta von for at least three years, completed at least 2,000 lessons, and achieved an average rating of at least 90% in their last six supervision sessions. The process also included two supervision visits from another region.**

The Omamas prepared for the exam using the Omama Handbook, most often in collaboration with a mentor or an Amal. Topics included, for example, the values of Cesta von, the principles of supportive care, a child's motor and speech development, reading books, handling a baby, the principles of a good lesson, and working with parents. The exam consisted of an online test and an open-ended interview on selected topics.

An important part of the preparation was also filming three videos of activities in families, which were reviewed by the program team or supervisors. If necessary, the participants edited the videos until they met the required quality standards for the app.

*I was really happy with those exams. Do you know how stressed out I was? But I realized that when I see all those kids together, making progress, it brings me great joy. The fact that the parents have learned to come regularly over the years. And now I managed it—I'm a senior.*

# Program Team Development

## Mentor training

We took a closer look at mentoring and the work of our mentors. This is the less visible part of the program—our mentors and their day-to-day work right out in the field. Yet it is they who support the Omamas, help maintain the quality of their work, and walk alongside them through both joyful and challenging situations.

We shared a lot, trained, and practiced how to ask questions, how to listen, how to set boundaries, and how to support the Omama so she has space to grow. We developed and worked intensively with a new structure for the mentoring conversation, which is more focused on helping the mentee discover her own resources so that she can find her own solutions during the conversation and be an active creator of solutions, rather than a passive recipient of advice. The new structure brought more certainty and a clearer direction to the conversations and provided a framework for the mentoring.

Some mentors recorded their mentoring sessions. In a small, closed group with an external supervisor and mentor Tomáš Macko, we used these recordings as training material during regular online meetings. The mentors practiced how to give feedback and how to ask for it directly from the mentees. Tomáš also accompanied the mentors to multi-day training sessions throughout the year.

We also introduced intervision. During a mentoring session, the mentor had an “observer” present, and afterward received respectful feedback—what went well and where there was room for improvement.

## Training for supervisors and regional coordinators

**In the fall of 2025, we organized a two-day workshop for regional coordinators and supervisors. It was the first time we had brought these two teams together in one place.**

Each region has its own coordinator and supervisor, and both of these roles share the unique aspect of knowing and meeting mentors and Omamas in the field. That is why it was beneficial for them to be together, exchange information, and agree on further mutual and effective cooperation.

Lecturers Tomáš Macko and Mária Dečová also participated in the training. The topic we studied and practiced was providing feedback in a supportive, coaching-oriented manner. This topic is very relevant to the work of regional coordinators and supervisors, as they work with people every day, support their development, and address various work situations in which quality feedback plays a key role. We recognize that the way we provide feedback has a significant impact on motivation, relationships, and the long-term development of individuals and teams, which is why this meeting and the chosen topic were highly appreciated by the participants.

# The Parenting gym

**In January 2025, the first pilot cycle of the Parenting gym was successfully completed in Hrabušice in collaboration with Omama Blanka and a group of 8 mothers.**

The goal of the sessions, which incorporated elements of filial therapy, was to deepen the relationship between parents and children, improve their mutual communication, and support parents in developing their skills. Filial therapy serves not only to support the child but also to strengthen the parents' competencies.

After the first cycle ended, several women shared that they had begun to think more about parenting, setting boundaries, and establishing rules for their children. Interest in a second cycle arose directly from the community.

Eight mothers approached Blanka, expressing that they, too, would like to try the parenting workshop. The second cycle of the program was successfully completed during the summer months.

In the fall of 2025, we launched the third cycle of the Parenting gym in Zborov with a group of six moms. The sessions took place weekly, lasting approximately 1.5 hours, and were led by our in-house team: supervisor Valika and regional coordinator Iva.

The mothers appreciated the opportunity to better understand their children's behavior, try new parenting approaches, and observe gradual yet noticeable changes in their children, in themselves, and in their parent-child relationship. The practical exercises, joint viewing and analysis of videos of mothers playing with their children, and specific phrases that the mothers could immediately apply to their daily lives proved to be particularly beneficial.



## Feedback from participants

Building a relationship and spending time together:

***"I realized that my child is happy when I'm with them, and it confirmed to me that they're glad to be with me."***

Improvements in the child's behavior:

***"The child is calmer, happier, and smiles more."***

Emotional connection and understanding:

***"The most powerful moment was when my son called me 'Mom' for the first time, and now he wants to spend more time with me."***

Parent's personal development:

***"I've learned that we can explain things to the child calmly and teach him to stay calm without yelling."***

# After the program

## Alumni Reunion

**Omama Ivet, together with mentor Blaženka, organized the very first alumni reunion of the program in Sirk. The goal was simple: to see each other again, say hello, reminisce about our shared journey, and create a space where families can meet one another.**

Twenty-four children attended the gathering, along with their parents—mothers and fathers alike. Even upon arrival, it was clear they were looking forward to the event. Many families arrived early. We welcomed them with balloons and a small treat, and as they entered, we called the children by name one by one. It was a lovely moment for everyone: both children and parents entered with smiles and a natural sense of pride that they “belonged among the graduates”.

The program had an informal atmosphere; at first, conversations and lively chatter dominated, as everyone wanted to share their news all at once. The gathering was very pleasant, as the families know each other and share a common experience. At the end, we took a group photo together as a reminder that even after the program ends, it remains important to maintain these relationships.

A similarly pleasant experience was provided by Omama Žanetka from Bačkov, who rehearsed a St. Nicholas Day program with the program’s graduates. They also invited the preschool director to the performance, who came along with a teaching assistant. The gathering created an opportunity for interaction between the families and the preschool. At the same time, it encouraged the children to perform, experience success, and boost their self-confidence.



## Contact with preschools

**We view a child’s entry into kindergarten as another important milestone in supporting child development. In some marginalized communities, however, parents and preschool staff have few opportunities to get to know each other before the child starts preschool. That is why this year we focused on creating opportunities for joint meetings, introducing the OMAMA program, and building natural relationships.**

We organized several joint activities. In some places, we presented the program directly in the preschools; in others, we also demonstrated selected parts of the lessons. In several communities, preschool staff even came to visit the parent clubs.

We believe it makes sense for parents and teachers to get to know each other and have the opportunity to experience pleasant, informal interaction together. In this way, a bridge of trust can gradually be built, which facilitates the child’s adaptation to preschool and supports cooperation between the family and the school.

# Update and creation of methodological materials

## The Manual 2 for Omamas

After three years of working with Manual 2, which we use in lessons with parents and children aged 1.5 to 3 years, we have updated it based on our field experience. The revisions were based on what parents actually need in their work and what has proven effective in families.

We have added new aids and books to the manual and expanded the possibilities for working with nursery rhymes, which naturally support speech development. For the Play Wisely cards, we have developed a more specific methodological description and set up a schedule for their regular repetition every month to ensure consistent use.

For selected activities, we added an **“ALTERNATIVE”** section so the manual can adapt to different children and situations. This helps caregivers tailor the activity to the child's current abilities, whether by simplifying it or, conversely, appropriately expanding it.

The actual replacement of the manual in the field required separate, precisely planned logistics. However, while placing materials into folders, replacing the old version with the new one, and shredding the original documents, we managed to accomplish something important alongside our work: being together as a team. We are glad that even such a task became an opportunity to spend time together.



## A Guide to Parent Clubs

**New topics for parent clubs emerged from the initiative of the mentors. The Guide to Parent Clubs—DromenDar was created and piloted in eleven communities from October 2025 to February 2026.**

The content is based on UNICEF’s “Caring for Caregivers” approach and focuses on working with emotions, respectful communication, motherhood, and the basics of financial responsibility. The activities are tailored to real-life experiences within intergenerational poverty. The foundation of success is close collaboration between the mentor and the Omama. Omama first experiences and works through the topic during mentoring sessions. Subsequently, either on her own or with the mentor’s support, she leads a meeting with parents directly in the community. The clubs thus create a safe space built on trust, active listening, and respect.

The pilot confirmed that the more technical parts need to be simplified for practice. It also provided important tips on how to involve Omamas more actively in leading the sessions and how to effectively organize the clubs when children are present. Practice has also shown that a single topic can be developed gradually across multiple clubs. Omamas revisit these topics during regular family lessons, so new skills aren’t lost after the club ends but continue to thrive within the community.

Starting in March 2026, clubs will be implemented in all OMAMA program communities using new topics. We will continue to expand the topics based on parents’ needs and collect ongoing feedback from the field.

***(note: the name “DromenDar” is inspired by the Romani word “drom” = path, or “dromen” = guide. “Dar” is a gift in Slovak. Thus, DromenDar = A Path That Is a Gift)***



# AMAL program

**The goal of the AMAL program is to help Omamas feel more confident working with children, as well as during training and educational sessions. Another success of the program is when an Omama decides to finish school, earn her high school diploma, or obtain another qualification. In the AMAL program, we systematically prepare them for this, and if they wish, we also support them throughout their studies.**

When they first joined the program, the Omamas were a bit apprehensive. They didn't want to relive what many of them remembered from school: tension, misunderstanding, fear of speaking up, comparisons, ridicule, or being ignored. Many didn't have fond memories, and school wasn't a place they liked to revisit—not even in their minds, let alone in reality. We were all the more pleased, then, as the conversations about learning gradually shifted. As they began to recall not only negative experiences but also pleasant moments, funny situations, and friends, many even remembered the names of teachers who were “different.” During lessons with the instructors and Amals, they discovered that learning could be different. In a calm, safe environment, with a positive atmosphere and at a suitable pace. And that they, too, are still capable of and eager to learn. In lessons with the instructors, they explain and discuss the topic and curriculum; with the teaching assistants, they go over specific points they didn't understand or need more practice with.

At the end of the cycle, they also take a test to assess which parts of the curriculum they have mastered well and what they still need to reinforce. Thanks to their experience with testing and final presentations, where they present a selected topic to the group, they learn to manage their time, resilience, and stress. They learn strategies they can use during testing, practice various types of exercises, and, with the support of a mentor or instructor, work through expectations and frustration. Thanks to AMAL, several young women have decided to return to school, and we are delighted about this. They have finally been given the opportunity to kickstart their education, and through their own experience, they have realized that they have what it takes.

## Monika's story: She got her driver's license and is studying in high school

My name is Monika Kompušová, I'm 29 years old, and I've been working as a mentor in the Cesta von program for 3 years. It's my first job ever, and I enjoy it because I love children and want to help them since they need it. I speak three languages: Hungarian, Romani, and Slovak.

I joined the AMAL program because I wanted to expand my vocabulary and better understand more difficult words, as well as improve my reading comprehension. At AMAL, I was paired with an amazing mentor named Dominika. She taught me many things, such as not being afraid to answer even if I make mistakes, and she taught me how to read books. I didn't read books before. Together, we read a few books that she let me choose. Dominika isn't just a teacher—she's also a friend who stands by you in any situation. And I'm so glad I got to meet her.

Then I decided to try applying for a driver's license; I got it two years ago, and a year later I applied to a high school with a graduation exam in Košice. AMAL motivated me. I wasn't afraid that I wouldn't understand something, not even during the entrance exams, because those Slovak language lessons helped me a lot. They reminded me of elementary school, and it was useful to review it all again because I had already forgotten quite a bit of what I'd learned. So the AMAL program is a good and useful way to expand your vocabulary and knowledge. And most importantly, the people there are amazing. THANK YOU.

# We're connecting AMAL with all our programs

**AMAL was originally created to support Omamas and to help them grow. In 2025, we also focused on linking it with other programs.**

Through questionnaires, interviews, feedback, and consultations with colleagues in the field, we mapped the needs of FILIP clients, as well as the needs of young people from ZEBRA clubs. While the Omamas are in a position where Slovak helps them perform their work better, FILIP clients are often looking for work and need more intensive language training tailored to this area. Young people from ZEBRA clubs attend school and need to learn Slovak so they can master the curriculum and meet the demands of their grade level.

We are thus gradually piloting new courses based on proven materials and methods while taking into account the specific needs of each program and its clients. They are then able to apply what they've learned in real-life situations, are motivated to continue, and find meaning in the process. We are further advancing the learning system, quality standards, and proven processes through the Academy, thanks to which our best practices in educating people from low-income communities are being refined and integrated into organizational and systemic frameworks.



## OMAMA

Last year, we had the first Omamas who completed Version D of the AMAL program. It focused on reading a book together (Born Guilty by Trevor Noah, in Slovak), diverse social topics, and highlighted selected words for spelling practice. It also inspired the use of the same book for sessions with leaders, which we tailored specifically for them. In addition, all basic levels for omamas—A, B, and C, which are always completed in two cycles—were fully enrolled, as was the pilot version of the current F course.

As is our tradition, this summer we created a preparatory course for brand-new omamas in the organization so that, even before the first cycle, they could learn to respond to email and Zoom requests, but above all, so they could believe that their Slovak is good enough to communicate confidently and adapt more quickly to the new work environment. All six did a great job, and today they are part of the AMAL program and have their own “amals,” who have helped them advance to the next level and created a safe space for them filled with friendship and acceptance.

A new initiative in the AMAL—OMAMA collaboration was the concept of a parents' club to develop reading skills through experiential reading for children aged approximately 1–4 years. The book *My Cat Tamtam* proved to be a success for us, offering a playful and creative approach to the club, familiar settings known even to children from these communities, and plenty of ideas for creative workshops as well as painting cat whiskers on faces at the end of the session. With this activity, we visited the Omamas and their clients with children in Luník IX, Boliarovo, Kecerovce, and Sečovce.

## FILIP

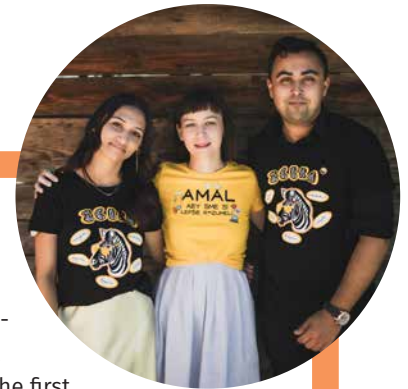
At the end of the year, we managed to establish a more meaningful and effective collaboration with the FILIP program. Although we had previously successfully integrated some clients into joint lessons with Omamas or found them a suitable small group, broader collaboration or a separate group remained an unfulfilled goal. At the same time, we felt that a separate course tailored to the needs, daily realities, and challenges of FILIP clients—challenges that most mothers have already successfully overcome—would be ideal (gaining confidence in communicating in Slovak and with the majority population, working with Zoom and email, preparing to enter the job market, but especially building healthy self-confidence, self-presentation, and developing new ideas and habits). We view the “Napredovanie”/ Advancement course and its participants from Kecerovce as an ideal springboard; we visited them at the end of the year and conducted initial informal interviews about their situation, needs, feelings, and the greatest challenges they face in communication. We also communicated with the Carpathian Foundation, which supports the UPre Women project, within which we prepared similar presentations and topics to support and empower women living in Luník IX—we plan to implement these in person as well. We will launch the online version in spring 2026 with FILIP clients from Jarovnice and Lenartov, and we are very much looking forward to it.

## ZEBRA

For the second year in a row, the leaders continued with year-round Slovak language lessons once a week. After the first year, which focused on rules, exceptions, and tricky points, we moved on to detailed listening comprehension, more challenging fill-in-the-blank exercises, and a variety of social and psychological topics related to their work, leadership, and youth work. In the summer, when new colleagues from Zborov joined us, we also started reading Trevor together, and so far this new initiative has proven very successful.

Starting in September, we launched joint Slovak language lessons for youth from the Zebra Clubs as well. Since most of the children are still in formal education or are considering returning to school, we tailor these sessions to their needs and expectations. We tailor the lessons to the material covered in the current school year and review everything necessary for classwork or for the future (such as make-up exams or entrance exams). We use our own presentations, online exercises, and entertaining videos to reinforce the knowledge they've gained in school and fill in any gaps in a fun and engaging way.

Lessons take place in the afternoons at three Zebra Clubs so far. The participating children are highly motivated and enjoy attending the lessons, as evidenced by their regular attendance and performance. Our goal is not only to teach them a perfect version of Slovak, but above all to spark their curiosity, instill a joy of learning, and boost their confidence in everyday communication.



# We also strengthen other skills

## Webinars

**During the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> cycles, we once again organized several webinars that broke from the usual format of group lessons taught in smaller groups. In the spring, we decided to veer away from the topic of languages, although some lesser-known ones were mentioned—our guest was Marta Dušková, who prepared an overview of the most critical moments in first aid for the Omamas. This allowed the seniors to theoretically prepare for unexpected situations in the field, learn to distinguish between life-threatening situations and those that can be treated at home, and review the ideal scenario for calling emergency medical services.**

In June, we were honored by a visit from writer Daniel Hevier, who was generous with his praise for the work of the entire organization, as well as with his rich experiences—including those from the war. During the war, he taught Roma men and spoke of them fondly; he even expressed a desire to track them down and asked about the students' current locations, wondering if any of them lived nearby. At the end, we wrote poems about this experience, and in many of them, we discovered promising poetic souls.

We also invited a group of leaders to a webinar with Denník N reporter Vladimír Šnidl. Our guest has long been deeply engaged with the topics of internet safety and disinformation. Many may know him as @krotimehoaxy, and thanks to him, many young people have attended similarly focused discussion sessions at school. He explained to us the biggest risks of the internet and social media—even broken down by gender—how to talk to young people about this topic, what to (not) avoid, and how to “train” an algorithm.

We also commemorated the legacy of November 17 and the Velvet Revolution with Post Bellum director Sandra Polovková. We discussed freedom and democracy, which led to many interesting reflections and the sharing of personal memories.

The end of the year traditionally featured a Christmas webinar, where we had secret guests for whom we prepared a Christmas quiz. The participants and leaders quickly guessed who they were, and we were able to watch a delightful Christmas competition between Juraj Bačo and Kristína Tormová.





## Testing Slovak Language and Digital Skills

**At the start of Cycle 9, we created an online test designed not only to assess knowledge of the Slovak language but also to evaluate the digital skills of the mothers and children participating in the AMAL program.**

The test consisted of five sections: listening comprehension, grammar, reading comprehension, writing, and self-reflection (self-assessment of language and digital skills). Since participants completed the test online, certain digital skills were also required, such as playing an audio recording, selecting the correct answers, typing full sentences on a keyboard, etc. We plan to use this test as a tool to compare the progress made over the course of two cycles, i.e., during one “school” year. Omamas will take the test for the first time in September, at the beginning of one cycle, and then repeat the same test in June, at the end of the next cycle. We want to identify the areas where progress has been made, what causes the greatest difficulties, and what to focus on during instruction. At the same time, we consider this a good supplement to our traditional tests, which Omamas take at the end of each cycle.

# Improving quality and increasing challenge

**At AMAL, we continuously monitor what our Omamas need in their work and adapt the course content accordingly. This year, we therefore launched an expert course designed for Omamas with several years of experience who are ready to work at an advanced language level and further develop their professional skills. The course, prepared and led by Michaela, builds on their existing field experience and creates space for a deeper understanding of the situations they encounter when working with families.**

The course content focuses on four areas important for the work of Omamas: intercultural understanding, supportive care for children and families, communication and collaboration, and self-development. During group sessions, participants jointly analyze field situations, discuss their own experiences, and use role-playing to explore ways to respond in challenging or conflict-ridden situations. They learn to identify emotions and communicate them to others using the principles of nonviolent communication. They also develop the ability to express their opinions, set boundaries, and conduct difficult conversations, which contributes to their long-term ability to

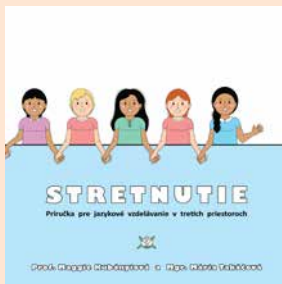


manage not only the care of the children in the program but also their own well-being.

Individual sessions are also an important part of the course. During these sessions, the mothers read books that help them develop their language skills and their ability to tell their own stories. Through reading, conversations, and writing reflections, they practice narrative skills, learn to name their experiences, and share them in conversations with others.

## Collaboration with the University of Leeds

In 2025, we published the English version of the handbook Encounter, which was developed through a research collaboration with Professor Maggie Kubanyi of the University of Leeds as part of the broader ETHER research project: Ethics and Aesthetics of Encounter with the Other. The handbook is intended for teachers, educators, and people working in multilingual environments. It maps the functioning of the AMAL program and offers perspectives, principles, and activities that challenge deficit-based perceptions of language and take into account the ethical dimension of the educational process. The handbook illustrates current and critical theories in the field of language education in a practical way and invites reflection on the potential impacts of a different perspective on language development and the personal growth of teachers and students, as well as on mutual understanding and interpersonal relationships in various contexts. In this way, we can extend our expertise beyond Slovakia to contexts where language can be viewed primarily as an opportunity.

Hmm, well, but when I started working as an Omama and committed to it, started attending those online classes, at first I felt that fear again, like, I don’t know, I can’t really put a name to it, but that fear, you know. But then, as the class went on and after... I noticed that over the whole year or so, I was probably the most talkative one, not that I want to brag or anything. I was just talking all the time. I started to really enjoy it.”***

# Volunteers at Cesta von

## Support for Amals

**Throughout the year, we organized several meetings and training sessions in various formats for our volunteers. The goal of the webinars was to support the volunteers in developing the skills needed to work with the women and participants.**

In the spring, we managed to host a Zoom session with linguist Lucia Molnár Satinská. Together, we explored the topic of multilingualism, discussed how to approach it in the context of Omama, and received valuable insights and recommendations. Another webinar was dedicated to the topic of intergenerational poverty and was organized in collaboration with the FILIP program. The Amals had the opportunity to better understand the broader context of poverty and its impact on family life.

At the end of the year, we took a break for a training session focused on our inner selves, healthy boundaries, and self-care. Led by psychologist Karolína Tobiašová, the topic of optimal functioning in volunteering and in everyday life received positive feedback from the Amals and led to a nice and open discussion.

The most powerful moments, however, were the in-person meetings. In October, a two-day in-person gathering took place in Košice, where several volunteers had the chance to meet the team for the first time, get to know their colleagues and the “Omamas,” discuss their work, and enjoy some cultural activities. On the first evening, they went to a concert at the Lasica Philharmonic Hall, and the next day, they attended a performance by the Romathan Theater with the Omamas. At the end of the year, we also organized smaller Christmas gatherings in Bratislava and Košice.





## Amals for ZEBRA

**The ZEBRA program features volunteers who regularly provide online tutoring to children from marginalized communities.**

Tutoring takes place online on a one-on-one basis, typically for one hour per week. Volunteers help children with various school subjects according to their needs, most often with math, English, and Slovak. This format allows the pace and method of instruction to be tailored to their current needs.

For many children, tutoring with an adult from the majority population is an important source of support not only for learning but also for creating a positive experience. They have the opportunity to ask questions, revisit material they didn't understand, and gradually build greater confidence in school. At the same time, these are regular meetings that the children look forward to and sign up for on their own. The online format allows volunteers from different locations to connect with children who would otherwise not have access to such support.

In 2025, volunteers in the ZEBRA program taught a total of approximately 600 hours. Both the number of hours and the number of participating children continue to grow. Feedback from the children shows that they view tutoring as useful help with schoolwork, but also as a pleasant time spent talking and learning. Through regular meetings, stable and supportive relationships develop between the children and volunteers, which are an important part of the entire program.

*For several months now, I've been tutoring Dáška, who is about to graduate from high school, at Cesta von. She is incredibly talented, thoughtful, and puts a lot of effort into her studies. People from the Romani community are often viewed through the lens of various negative stereotypes, frequently without much understanding of their situation. But my experience from talking with Dáška is completely different. Tutoring isn't a one-way street for me—it's more of a mutual relationship where we learn from each other. Thanks to Dáška, I'm getting to know her world, and every time I admire the inner strength with which she thinks about her future. I therefore see the value of volunteering not only in the fact that I can help her with school, but especially in the fact that our regular meetings allow us to get to know each other's worlds and build a connection. It is precisely in connecting people from marginalized communities with the majority that I see the great power of Cesta von's work. When we get to know a specific person, the "us and them" mentality disappears, and the experience we've gained from one another in this way, we can pass on to those around us.*

# The FILIP program

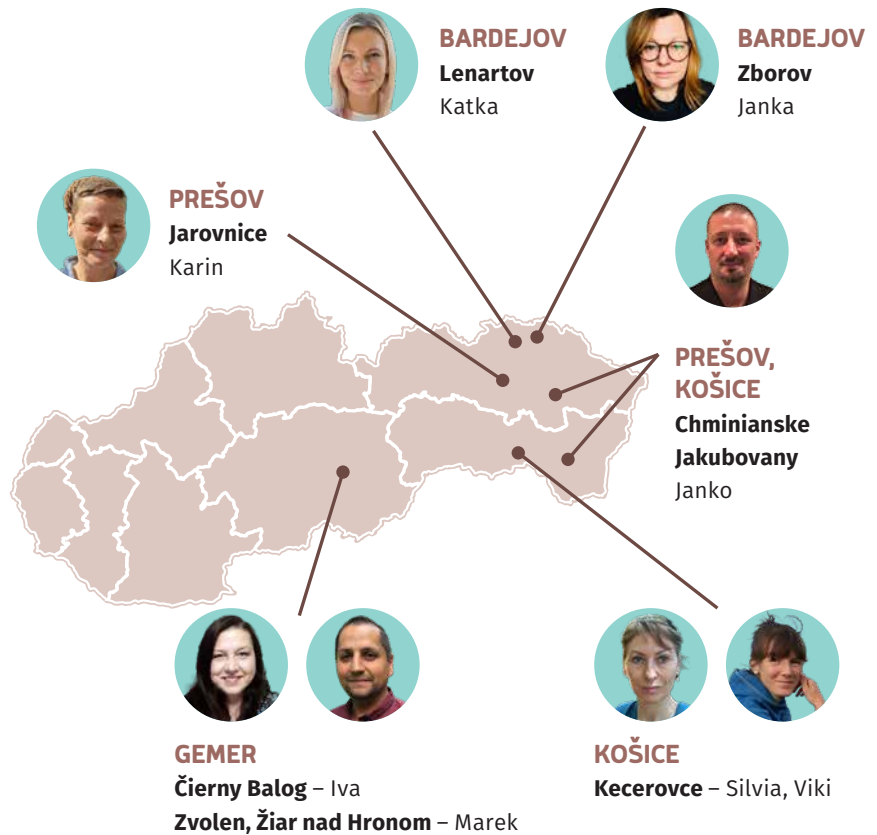
**In 2025, the FILIP program accompanied a total of 108 families on their journey from generational poverty to stability; of these, 21 families successfully completed the three-year program this year.**

Starting in January, six mentors worked in the field; in September, the team expanded to include two new mentors, Karin and Katka, allowing us to open two new communities in Jarovnice and Lenartov. Thirty people participated in the “Napredovanie”/Advancement group program. We tested collaboration with a therapist and organized group therapy for 8 women in Zborov. Impact measurement confirms that change is nonlinear, but it tends to be most consistent in the areas of finances and debt and also strengthens families’ inner self-confidence. Despite challenging conditions, we see meaningful, lasting shifts. The impact often extends to children as well—they benefit from a more stable environment, lower stress, and clearer boundaries at home.

# Empowering People in Communities

## Katarína's Story from Zborov

Katarína's initial motivation to join the Advancement program was the shopping voucher that participants receive for their active participation at each meeting. At that time, she was living day to day. She had no clear plans, didn't think about the future, nor about how her attitude might affect her children. School was not a priority for her; work seemed out of reach, and she perceived the system as something working against her. She often attributed responsibility to circumstances. During the Advancement program itself, her perspective began to shift. Gradually, she admitted to herself that part of the situation was in her own hands. This moment was a turning point. When she went through the process a second time, this time as a co-facilitator, her decision to work on herself solidified. However, a change in mindset did not yet mean stable motivation. She and her family joined the FILIP program, and it was only during the mentoring sessions that she was able to grasp her inner resolve. Regular conversations gave her the feeling that she wasn't alone on this journey. She had someone by her side who accompanied her, identified obstacles, and helped her find concrete steps to take. Through the Employment Office, she completed a retraining course in nursing. During her internship at an organization, she received a job offer. She has been working there for 11 months now. She sets aside money from every paycheck. Gradually, she added a small room to her cottage and set up a kitchenette. In addition, while working, she took the placement exams between special and elementary school and began studying at a high school in September. She understands how important education is and supports her children in their studies as well. Her transformation is not a one-time event; it is a long-term process of struggling with the system and with herself. Today, she realizes that she is the one who can change the course of her own life and that of her children.

*I see Katarina's story as an example of how real change happens when an inner decision is combined with long-term support. During the mentoring sessions, her self-confidence and ability to take responsibility gradually grew. I see how she works systematically, plans, and overcomes obstacles. Her progress is not accidental; it is the result of conscious self-improvement and a willingness not to give up, even under difficult conditions. She is proof that even a small impulse can trigger a profound personal transformation if a person is willing to work on themselves.*

# We're expanding Advancement program to other communities

**The Advancement program at Cesta von is now in its third year. A key aspect of the program is that participants from marginalized communities are viewed as experts on their own lives. Through mental imagery and experiential activities, they explore the hidden rules of social classes, map their resources, and seek a path to stability.**

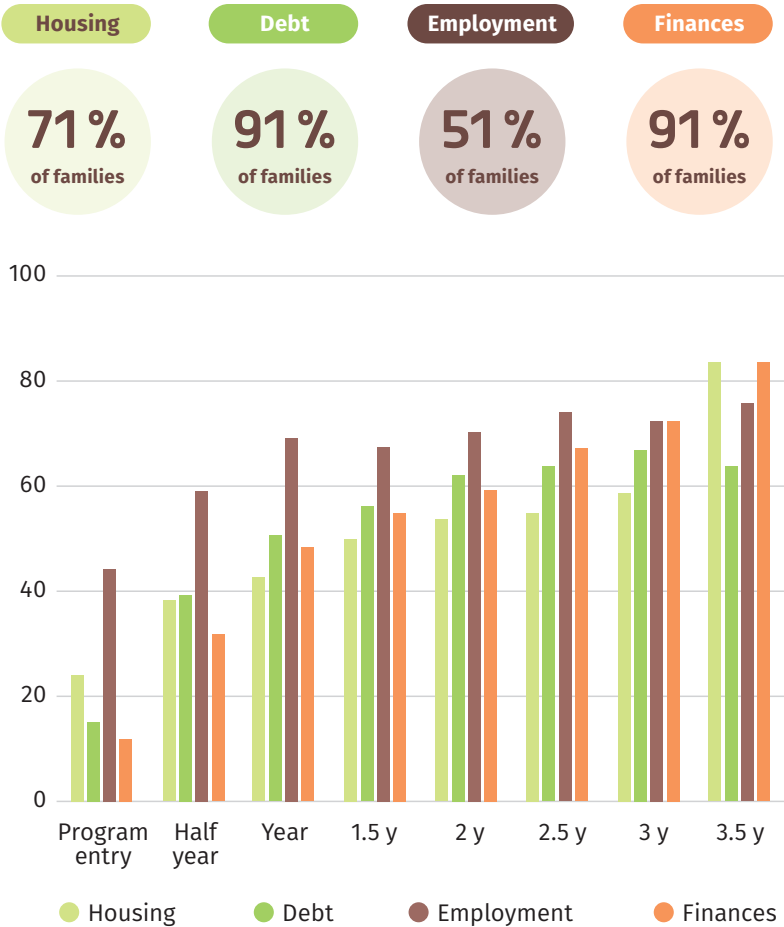
The year 2025 was marked by expansion and innovation. In addition to Zborov, where we ran our fourth group, we successfully brought the program to Kecerovce, where there were two groups, and to Čierny Balog. The facilitators approached the process with tremendous courage and creativity. Proof of this is the new “balloon activity,” through which the facilitators in Kecerovce managed to inject dynamism into the complex Theory of Change. This idea also inspired our partners from the American organization aha!Process, and after being translated into English, it made its way to American facilitators. A group in Muskogee, Oklahoma, even incorporated it into their program. A learning community has formed between our team and the trainers from the American organization who trained us. Regular online meetings create a space where we grow together, share, and inspire one another. Advancement has proven to be a powerful tool that initiates an internal process of change, teaches participants to plan their first steps, and empowers individuals to take responsibility for their lives.

***In 2025, a total of 42 participants went through the Advancement program, and 8 of them subsequently joined the FILIP program with their families and continue to work toward their goals.***

*When I joined the FILIP program, my life was in chaos. Debts, foreclosures, a run-down house, children without a place of their own—every day was a struggle for survival. I felt shame and fear; I didn't know what to do with my money. Gradually, I learned to plan: to record expenses, to negotiate payment plans with debt collectors. Thanks to Advancement, I understood my options. After it ended, I completed a caregiving course, got a job at a social services facility, and learned to stand on my own two feet. Money no longer went out randomly, but according to a plan; we started paying off debts and repairing the house. Advancement gave me both the tools and the courage. I'm proud that I've taken control of my finances, that my job provides security, and that instead of fear, I feel hope. This isn't the end; it's a new beginning. I'm learning that change is possible if you don't give up.*

# Pilot EMDR Group Psychotherapy in Zborov

**In 2025, in collaboration with clinical psychologist and psychotherapist PhDr. Lucia Hrešková, PhD., we implemented a pilot program of group EMDR psychotherapy for women from socially disadvantaged backgrounds. The goal of the program was to promote stabilization, the processing of traumatic memories, and the strengthening of psychological resilience through bilateral stimulation, imagination, and a safe group environment.**

This approach is based on the principles of trauma-informed and culturally sensitive psychotherapy, which respects the specific characteristics of the community and allows for nonverbal, symbolic processing of experiences without the need to verbalize details.

Group psychotherapy in the EMDR-IGTP-OTS format consisted of a total of 12 sessions and was open to seven participants.

The program's effectiveness was evaluated using a combination of quantitative and qualitative methods.

Following the completion of the 12 sessions of group EMDR-IGTP-OTS therapy, a marked and clinically significant reduction in symptoms was observed across all areas assessed. The greatest reduction was observed in depression and anxiety symptoms. The results indicate stabilization of emotional experience, better self-regulation, and improved overall mental functioning.

Qualitative data suggest that the participants:

- have a better understanding of their own experiences and are more aware of their boundaries,
- have gained a greater ability to regulate their emotions and manage stress,
- improve the quality of their relationships and communication within the family,
- and find inner peace, relief, and meaning.

Three months after the program ended, it can be concluded that:

- the therapeutic effects persist,
- the women are actively using the regulation tools they learned,
- boundaries and self-esteem have been strengthened,
- the quality of relationships has improved,
- self-care has increased,
- and signs of post-traumatic growth are emerging.

The results indicate that, within this cultural context, this therapeutic format has proven to be a sensitive, effective, and community-sustainable tool for psychotherapeutic intervention, capable of bridging a professional approach with cultural relevance and human dignity.

***Group EMDR psychotherapy with women from marginalized communities in Zborov was a profound experience of trust and courage for me. Seeing how they gradually allowed themselves to be kinder to one another and began to feel more secure within themselves gradually translated into greater care for their own health, setting boundaries, and responding more calmly in their relationships. It was an honor to be part of this process.***

# Mentor Training through NBS

In 2025, we launched ZEBRA—Money Super Training, an action-oriented financial training program based on experiential learning. It is not only a new methodology for the 5peňazí/5cents (NBS—National Bank of Slovakia) program but also a new challenge and a helping hand for teenagers from marginalized communities, who often lack positive financial role models around them and may find the world of money distant and abstract. That is precisely why this educational program was created—one that draws on practical experience, stories, and real-life situations—so that financial literacy is understandable, “tangible,” and immediately applicable.

The training was attended by FILIP mentors, ZEBRA leaders, and ZEBRA mentors—that is, people who guide young people in the clubs and know how to teach them in a playful way. During the training, we experienced firsthand what this looks like in practice: we laughed, filmed videos, built paper towers, acted out role-play scenarios, and at the same time deeply reflected on how to offer financial literacy to young people from generational poverty without a top-down mentoring approach, but with respect, safety, and clear steps.

The methodology consists of 12 modules and gradually covers topics such as earning money, smart shopping, budgeting and savings, saving and goals, bank accounts, debt and fraud prevention, digital security, resources for a balanced life, and how money affects relationships. Starting in May, our trained FILIP mentors began leading training sessions directly in the clubs: Viki in Kecerovce, Janko in Chminianske Jakubovany, and starting in September—after the opening of the new club—Janka also in Zborov. FILIP mentors also apply the principles of Super Training in individual mentoring sessions with adults.



***“We consider the development of a financial education methodology for young people living in intergenerational poverty to be an important step. We appreciate the systematic and high-quality work of the organization Cesta von. Teenagers often make their first financial decisions in an environment where positive role models are lacking. We therefore view financial education as a tool for prevention and for strengthening their self-confidence and life opportunities. We believe that this methodology, through regular financial education in Zebra clubs, will contribute to greater protection against financial problems and increase their chances of leading a more independent and dignified life.”***

# ZEBRA program

**The year 2025 was a year of growth for the Zebra program, but also a year of strengthening what lies at its core—relationships, trust, and daily work with young people. In four communities, more than 300 children and teenagers met regularly, coming to the clubs not only for help with school but also for a safe place where they can be themselves.**

A major highlight of the year was the opening of a new club in Zborov. When the doors first opened, more children came than we expected. Today, the club has around 60 participants, and others are waiting for their chance. However, it's not just the numbers that matter, but what the opening signified—that a space has emerged in this new community where young people feel accepted and supported. The program throughout the year was built on a combination of tutoring, group activities, and hands-on experiences. The children learned how to manage their emotions, how to communicate, but also how to handle money and plan for their future. Moments “outside” the club were also very important—trips, joint events, or visits to places many of the children were seeing for the first time. But Zebra isn't just about activities. It's about the fact that when something goes wrong, someone is always there. That a leader listens, encourages, and believes, even when a child doesn't yet believe in themselves. It is precisely this daily presence that gradually transforms stories—from uncertainty to hope.



***The year 2025 has shown us once again that change doesn't happen all at once. It comes quietly, step by step. And that is exactly how the children at Zebra grow.***

# The first summer ZEBRA Camp

**For many children, the 2025 Zebra camp was their first experience leaving their community for a few days. The suitcase they packed wasn't just about clothes—it also carried expectations, fears, and great curiosity.**

77 children from all three clubs gathered in one place. Some knew each other only from online tutoring; others were meeting for the first time. But after just a few hours, something began to emerge among them that cannot be planned—a sense that they belonged there.

The program was varied: sports, a trip to Sysľovisko, creative activities, a concert by the well-known Romani singer Vaneska Horáková, and a talent show. But the most important things happened in between. In conversations in the evenings in the rooms, in the support among the children, in the moments when someone dared to perform in front of the others for the first time. The camp was built on Zebra's values—caring, empathy, safety, respect, and authenticity.



For many, it was their first experience where they felt that someone took them seriously. That their opinion mattered. That they could do things they hadn't previously thought possible.

Singing the Zebra anthem became a ritual that gradually transformed the three different clubs into a single community.





The camp is thus not just a reward. It is an impulse. A moment that can change direction—subtly, but permanently.



Interestingly, the camp's impact doesn't end on its final day. The chance to go to camp has become a source of motivation throughout the year. The children know that participation is tied to their regular attendance at the clubs, so they try hard, persevere, and keep coming back.

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*When you ask me about camp, I immediately think of the pool, which I enjoyed the most. And then the carnival, where I had my own costume and was dressed as Batman. I liked that we sang the Zebra anthem every morning before activities, and I got to sing on stage too. I like to remember how we were all together. I was in a group led by Radko, and he treated us very well. No one yelled at me.*

# Support for Zebras in high schools

**When a young person decides to continue on to high school, it's often not just a matter of motivation. It's also a matter of money—for transportation, lunches, or basic school supplies. This is where the Zebra scholarship fund comes into the story.**

In 2025, it supported more than fourteen high school students who, without this help, would have struggled to stay in school. Support is not automatic—it is tied to regular attendance, effort, and involvement in the club. This way, the children know that they are building trust.

The way the fund operates is also important. The money does not go directly to families, but specifically toward school expenses. This ensures that the assistance truly serves its purpose—education.

Behind every scholarship is a specific story. A girl who wants to be a nurse. A boy who discovered a talent for music. Young people who are beginning to envision the future differently than the generations before them.



*The scholarship fund is not just financial aid. It is a signal: we believe in you. And sometimes that is all it takes for someone to persevere just a little longer.*

## We also empower leaders

**Behind every Zebra Club is a person who holds it together. Leaders aren't just activity organizers—they're the ones the kids turn to when things aren't going well, when they want to brag, or when they simply need someone to listen.**

That's why their training is crucial. In 2025, leaders underwent a series of training sessions that strengthened their ability to work with young people. They learned how to lead a group, facilitate discussions, foster motivation, and develop critical thinking. A significant portion of the training also focused on practical topics—financial literacy, managing emotions, and mentoring. The leaders tried out new methodologies, shared experiences, and learned from one another. Interestingly, the leaders' growth is immediately reflected in the clubs: better-run activities, more engaged children, and a safer environment. When a leader grows, the entire club grows. However, training is not a one-time event; it is a process. Just like children, leaders need time, support, and room to make mistakes. And that is precisely the strength of Zebra: everyone learns together.



*The training sessions gave me a wealth of new knowledge, skills, and experiences that I can apply both in practice and in my personal life. I've learned to communicate better with people, solve problems more effectively, and work in a team. Thanks to them, I've also gained greater self-confidence and the ability to adapt more quickly to new situations. The training showed me new ways of thinking and helped me develop critical thinking. In addition, I've mastered specific practical techniques that make my work easier and boost my productivity. Overall, the training has helped me grow both personally and professionally and prepared me for new challenges.*

## An editorial board was formed at the ZEBRA clubs

**Zebroviný emerged quietly from the need to tell parents and the community what was happening in the clubs. Today, however, they are much more than just a “newspaper.” They are the voice of young people. Three to four young people from each community are involved in the editorial board.**

The club participants themselves contribute to its creation. They write articles, conduct interviews, and select photos. In doing so, they learn not only technical skills but also how to articulate their experiences and stories.

For many, this is the first time they’ve created something and seen it in print. They hold the result of their work in their hands—something that has value even outside the club. Zebroviný reaches parents, partners, and the wider community, helping to break down stereotypes. At the same time, they serve as a bridge between worlds. They show that young people from these communities have something to say. That their stories are full of effort, talent, and humor. Zebroviný features reports on activities, personal stories, and dreams for the future. Sometimes simple, other times surprisingly bold.



Perhaps most importantly, Zebroviný gives young people the feeling that their voice matters. And when a person realizes that someone is listening, they begin to speak up. And that is where change begins.





# ACADEMY program

## The OMAMA program franchise model

**In 2025, we created the OMAMA program franchise model, which allows us to expand our proven approach to early childhood care to other regions and organizations.**

It is a systematic three-year collaboration model for franchisees that wish to implement the program according to our methodology. The model includes comprehensive support ranging from initial training through ongoing workshops, mentoring, and tutoring to evaluation and access to a detailed program manual and app. Our goal is not only to transfer know-how but also to ensure the quality and fidelity of the program in new settings. The model is designed so that organizations have sufficient support throughout the implementation period while gradually building their own capacity. We view this step as an important shift from direct program implementation to its scaling and long-term sustainability.

## Building partnerships for the pilot year

**Over the course of the year, we were able to identify and reach out to potential partners for the pilot implementation of the franchise model, particularly in the Banská Bystrica region.**

These were a mix of local governments and non-profit organizations that have experience working in communities and are also interested in developing support for families with young children. Following a series of individual meetings, we also organized a joint meeting of all participating partners. This created an opportunity to share expectations, establish the framework for collaboration, and define next steps. Another key moment was the affirmation of shared values. We agreed on the importance of early childhood care and our willingness to invest energy into the pilot year. The launch of the program will depend on securing funding, but we already sense a strong motivation among partners to get involved and work together to find solutions.





Our goal is to help these ideas grow and connect them with practical implementation. We believe that it is precisely the combination of local experience and support that can bring about sustainable solutions.

## Supporting social innovators

**In November, together with the DOM.ov Project, we organized the first meeting of future social innovators focused on addressing intergenerational poverty.**

The event in Bratislava provided a space for people who want to actively seek solutions and come up with new ideas. Discussions touched on topics such as employment, language skills development, access to education, and improving the situation in specific marginalized communities. An important part of the event also included conversations about human rights and systemic barriers that affect the lives of people living in poverty. We offered individual consultations and mentoring support to participants who came with specific proposals.



# Advocacy and systemic change

## The Year When Best Practices Became Law

**Seven years of building the Omama program, collecting data, and demonstrating that high-quality early care changes the lives of children trapped in generational poverty yielded one of the most significant results in the history of Cesta von in 2025. An amendment to the law, which we actively helped draft, introduced a new professional activity into the Slovak social services system—Parenting Skills Development—directly inspired by the work of Omama.**

Our early childhood care practice, already proven in hundreds of thousands of sessions with children from marginalized communities, is thus becoming part of the system. Starting in 2026, the state will contribute to the funding of this new service, for now from European funds, but this step has created the space for it to be funded directly from the state budget in the future—sustainably, systematically, and long-term.

## Our Path to Systemic Change

**Years before the legislative change, we built arguments, data, and relationships—simultaneously on several levels:**

- Cesta von is an active member of the inter-ministerial working group comprising the Ministry of Labor, Social Affairs, and Family of the Slovak Republic, the Ministry of Education of the Slovak Republic, and the Ministry of Health of the Slovak Republic. Within these groups, we advocated for and helped define what the new social service should look like, what quality it should ensure, and how it should be funded.
- The Slovak government approved the National Strategy for the Development of Coordinated Early Intervention and Early Care Services 2022–2030 and later the Action Plan for 2023–2025, in the drafting of which we were directly involved. These documents confirmed that early childhood issues are a political priority and committed Slovak authorities to systemic changes.
- As part of a joint effort, we also coordinated with other organizations affiliated with the Platform for Early Childhood Development—OdPerinky.
- Together with the University of Oxford, we measured the neurodevelopment of children enrolled in the OMAMA program. In January 2025, an article was published in the prestigious peer-reviewed scientific journal *European Journal of*



Pediatrics, which scientifically confirms that children in the OMAMA program achieve significantly better results in cognition, motor skills, and speech than their peers from generational poverty who did not receive intervention. These results served as a key argument in discussions with policymakers.

- In 2024, we conducted an in-depth evaluation of the OMAMA program in collaboration with the Czech organization Schola Empirica. The results confirmed that children enrolled in the program gradually catch up to the general population's level in developmental screenings as they grow older, and that parents who participate in the program spend more meaningful time with their children and better understand why it is important to regularly support their development.

## The analytical team piloted a new tool for measuring child development

**In the OMAMA program, we strive to ensure that every child has a chance at a successful start in life. That is why we have introduced the CREDI child development monitoring tool, developed by experts at Harvard University. It allows us to sensitively track children's progress from birth to age three and better understand their needs.**

CREDI helps us more accurately identify the areas where children are thriving and where they need more support. At the same time, it allows us to improve our methodology. The questionnaire is not filled out by parents, but by trained OMAMA staff, which reduces bias and ensures a consistent understanding of the questions. The results are then shared with the parents.

In the summer of 2025, we piloted the tool with 7 OMAMA staff members. Their feedback confirmed that CREDI is clear and easy to understand, and the results aligned with INTER-NDA measurements. Today, CREDI is part of the OMAMA app and helps us identify children at risk of developmental delays and refer them for professional help.

CREDI focuses on the child's actual abilities, not just their age. It tracks, for example, communication, movement, and social behavior, and naturally highlights where to focus in their development. It has replaced older tools that were not always sensitive to the context of marginalized communities.

CREDI isn't just for us, but especially for moms. It's an amazing tool to encourage them. When a mom sees the green icons in the app showing everything her child has learned over the past six months, it's a huge moment of pride for her. At the same time, our initial results show that children in the OMAMA program are making much greater progress in cognitive and motor development than their peers who are not in the program. Even in the area of mental health, our children achieve results comparable to those of children from the general population, confirming that the parent-child bond, which OMAMA strengthens, works.

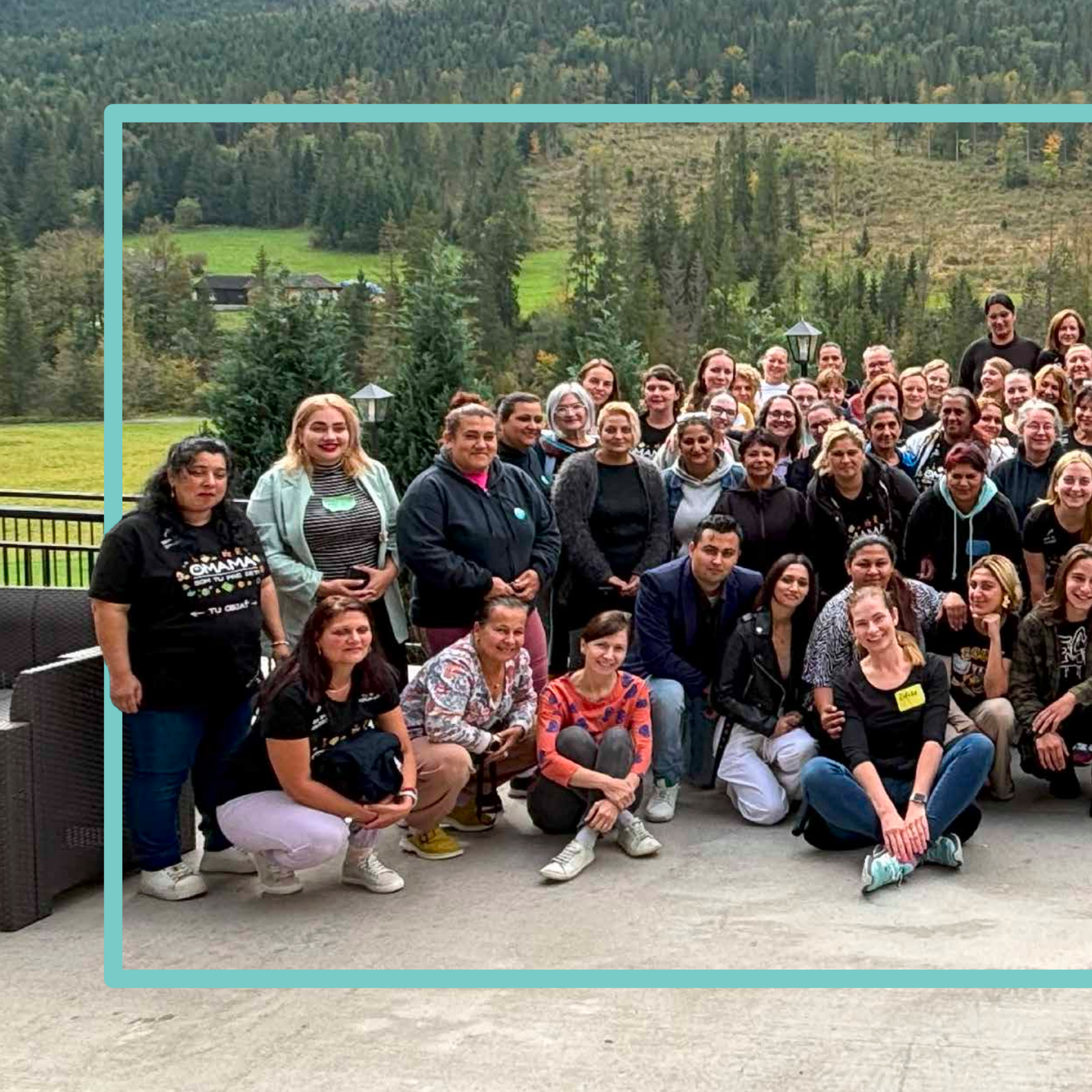
